

Covid-19 Code of Conduct

We are delighted to be able to welcome you to our building. To ensure that everyone attending can feel safe, we are continuing to be guided by our risk assessments in establishing guidelines for the use of our building. As we recognise that the Covid-19 situation continues to fluctuate, we regularly review our risk assessments and will adjust our guidelines accordingly. For full information about our Covid-19 roadmap, please contact the synagogue office.

To ensure that our risk assessments can be implemented, we kindly request that everyone attending follows our Code of Conduct.

As the most effective Covid-19 risk mitigation is to avoid exposure to the virus, we kindly ask that you refrain from attending the synagogue if you feel unwell, recognising that [Covid-19 symptoms](#) can appear like the common cold, and especially if you have recently tested positive for Covid-19.

We further ask you to

- Wear a face mask — covering your nose and mouth — in all shared areas of the synagogue (this includes the hallways and the toilet facilities) regardless of whether there are other people present.
- Pay attention to the notice boards at the entrance. We will update our notice boards regularly to tell you, for example, whether you are able to remove your face mask at certain times or in dedicated areas of the synagogue.
- If you are not certain about the guidance that applies to the activity that you are attending, please err on the side of caution and wear a face mask.
- Consult with your host about any specific guidance that might apply for the activity that you are planning to attend.
- Refrain from rearranging seats without consultation to ensure that social distancing can be maintained if required by our risk assessment.
- Refrain from closing windows to ensure that we can maintain good levels of ventilation at all times.
- Maintain good hand hygiene by using the sanitiser dispensers provided.

If you make a booking for others permitted to attend, you agree to make sure they understand and agree to comply with this Code and you accept responsibility for their compliance with this Code.
