



The Burial Cremation & Funeral Expenses Scheme (the “Scheme”)

Scheme rules

A printed copy can be requested from the Synagogue office.

Surcharges

The Scheme only pays for the cost of a standard funeral for a burial or a cremation. Any additional charges incurred will be invoiced to the member’s family or estate. The table overleaf shows the current and most common surcharges and is published on our website. A printed copy can also be requested via the Synagogue Office. An updated notice will be published in Davar annually. The website is the official means of notification.

Other surcharges may be incurred. The Funeral Director will always inform families about any surcharges.

Woodland burial

Woodland burial is available at GreenAcres Chiltern and Cheshunt Cemetery. There are surcharges as noted in the table overleaf.

Cremations

The Ark Synagogue conducts cremation services at Golders Green Crematorium, Hoop Lane and at GreenAcres Chiltern, Beaconsfield. There are surcharges for cremations held on a Sunday or a bank holiday as shown in the table overleaf.

Kings Funeral Directors

When a synagogue member who is included in the Scheme has died, the funeral director who must be instructed is Ronnie King of Kings Funeral Directors. Ronnie can be contacted 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including Bank Holidays and Jewish Festivals on 07595 956 936. Any charges incurred for the services of another funeral director will not be paid for by the Scheme.

Stone-settings and Memorials

The Scheme does not cover any of the costs associated with ordering and erecting a headstone or a memorial on a grave. Enquiries about headstones at Edgwarebury and Cheshunt cemeteries, memorials at GreenAcres, and all consecration services should be directed to Lisa Godsal or Tanya Garfield at Progressive Judaism, or to one of our Rabbis.
