



## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) following a death

### 1. How can I arrange a stone setting?

Please phone Liberal Judaism on 020 7580 1663. They will also be your contact for agreeing a date with one of our rabbis. You may find it useful to know that a stone setting usually takes place at least nine months after the funeral, to allow the ground to settle.

### 3. The funeral was a cremation. How can I arrange a suitable ceremony for burying or scattering the ashes?

- There are various options following a cremation in which to commemorate someone at either Golders Green Crematorium or Edgwarebury Cemetery.
- For Golders Green Crematorium, contact them directly on 020 8455 2374.

### 4. How can I ensure the synagogue can mark the anniversary of the death during the appropriate shabbat services? (Yahrzeit)
