
BM 1 & 2 HANDBOOK FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS



Introduction

Full details of our Bar/ Bat Mitzvah programme can be found in this year's course booklet. In this handbook, we want to provide a more detailed overview over the curriculum for students and parents. In the first term of this year, the class will learn about what it means to be the People of the Book. In the second term, the class will learn about modern day Israel with the final term focused on some of the important biblical prophets to explore how their words are relevant to us today.





Term Overview

Classes will be held on Saturday morning during term time. The Jewish Studies lesson for the BM class will run from 10 - 10:50am. If there is sufficient interest, we will also offer a Hebrew class from 11:15 - noon. On mornings when there is a family study session (five sessions through the year), there will not be a Hebrew class. Instead, we encourage families to attend the service together.
